Car Parking - Walton Gardens

The main visitor car park will be reserved for blue badge holders only (Up to 300 cars), a further 700 spaces are available on the grass overspill car park (this can involve a journey of up to 700m to the event site). A dropping off point is available adjacent to the bridge.

Park & Ride

An accessible, free, Park & Ride shuttle service will be operating from 9:30am from Wilderspool Park (off Greenalls Avenue WA4 6HL) - last bus from Walton Gardens 5:15pm.

Bus Services

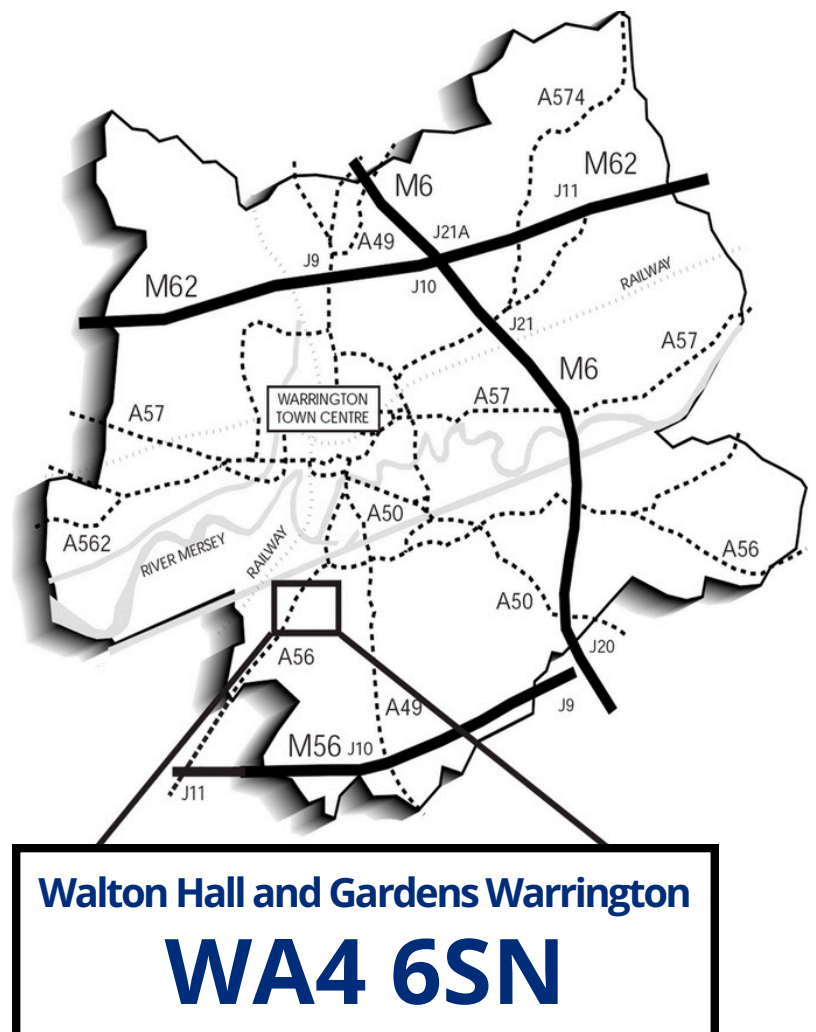
An accessible, free, bus service will run every 30 minutes from 9:30am from Warrington Bus Interchange - last bus leaving Walton Gardens at 5:15pm.

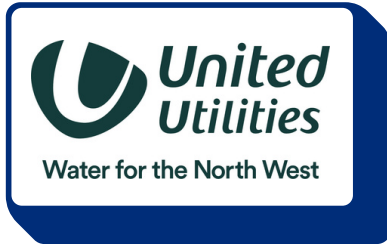
